### **Dress Code**

- Clothing that promotes sin or a sinful lifestyle is not allowed. Do not wear anything that promotes a band, movie, event, or product that is questionable.
- Swimsuits are not allowed in the dining hall or meeting rooms.
- Shoes must be worn when outside your room/dorm. (Water socks are recommended in the pool.)
- Tight-fitting garments are not suitable for camp.
- Wear a swimsuit cover, shirt, or wrap yourself in a towel to go to and from the pool.

### **Females**

- Tank tops, spaghetti strap, strapless, halter, and midriff tops are NOT allowed. We don't want to see your underwear or your belly.
- Short shorts are not allowed.
- Modest swimming suits are required. If you don't have a one-piece, you MUST swim with a T-shirt covering your swimsuit.

### **Males**

- Muscle shirts are not allowed.
- Modest swimming suits are required.
- Baggy shorts and pants are not allowed. We don't want to see your underwear/boxers, and we don't want it covered up by those long shirts, either.

### **Supply List**

- Bedding & linens (bunks are twin-sized), or sleeping bag and pillow.
- Bible, notebook & pen
- Stuff to keep your body clean (towel)
- Light jacket
- Modest clothing
- Modest bathing suit, cover-up & towel
- Spending money
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Watch
- Calling card (optional. Only 800 numbers may be dialed from the campground. Direct-dialed long distance calls are blocked.)

### **Camping Programs**

Everyone will be at the same campground, but there are three separate camping programs:

**Youth:** campers under 19 who were in grades 6-12 (2017/2018 school year)

**Junior:** campers over 9 who were in grades 3-5 (2017/2018 school year)

**Family Camp:** campers over 19. Fun classes provided for children who attend camp with their families.

**Children under 9 may NOT attend camp without their parent/guardian.**

## Rules for Youth & Junior Campers

- This is a Christian camp and is designed for the spiritual enrichment of all our campers. Therefore, Attendance is required at services.
- You must respect other people's property.
- You must adhere to dress code.
- You must give all prescription medicines to the camp nurse/medic at check-in. The camp nurse/medic will administer as prescribed.
- You are not allowed to leave the campground.
- You are not allowed in any dorm except your own.
- You are not allowed outside the dorm between lights out and 7:00am.
- You must obey Grounds Monitors and all camp staff.
- No smoking, matches, or fireworks allowed.
- No tobacco products, alcohol, or drugs allowed.
- No weapons of any kind allowed. If you are found with a weapon, you will be expelled from camp. The weapon will be confiscated and not returned.
- NO PDA
- No pets

- No electronic games, iPod, laser pointers, DVD players, televisions, laptop computers, or **cell phones** allowed.

## **And if there's a problem....**

Every effort will be made to address and correct the behavior, including the involvement of the camper's youth pastor, senior pastor, and the Camp Director. If necessary, the camper will be sent home. In that case, the youth pastor or senior pastor will be responsible for taking the camper home.

We reserve the right to search a camper's belongings, with or without consent, in the case of emergency.

## Medical Information & Consent to Treat

EVERY camper must complete the medical information portion of the registration form. This will be submitted to the camp staff.

Please include as much information as possible so you or your child can be treated if needed. In cases of emergency, the camp medical personnel will contact you.

## ADULT CAMPER INFORMATION

### Telephone Service at Camp

**Mobile Phones** service do pick up in certain areas and depend on your provider. There are a few pockets within the campground where you can get service.

**Private Rooms:** Bedding and linens are NOT provided. Bring a port-a-crib for small children. Linens for one double and two twin beds are needed.

**Dorms:** Bring bedding and linens. Beds are twin sized.
